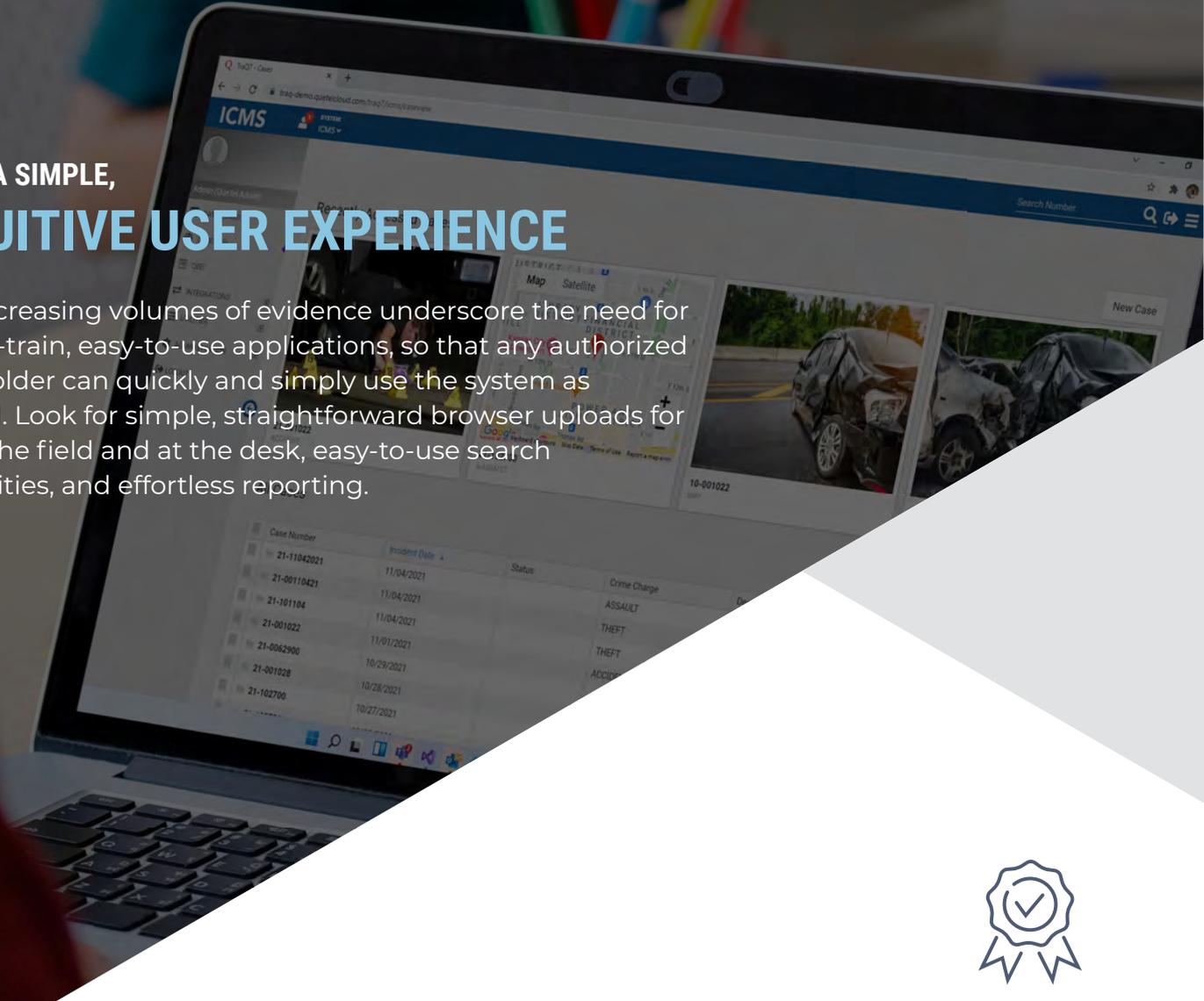
PROTECT CONFIDENTIALITY OF RECORDS
